

Editorial from the Church of the Good Shepherd

April 2025

Five years....

There has been much talk on the TV and radio recently looking back and reflecting on the fact that the COVID pandemic hit the UK five years ago. The first lockdown began; we entered a time of unknowing and there was fear for the future. There was also a lot of grief for lost loved ones, lost jobs, lost opportunities and for simply being unable to connect with friends and family.

Holy Saturday is the day between Good Friday, when we remember Jesus dying on the cross, and Easter Sunday, when we celebrate His rising to new life. For us, on this side of Easter, who know the story, it might be a day for getting things prepared for Sunday, perhaps making sure you've enough Easter eggs, checking everything's ready for the family gathering or, in my case, writing an Easter sermon. But, for those first disciples who witnessed Jesus' brutal death or who ran away and hid, "Holy Saturday" was a time of fear, grief and unknowing, with many of them locked away in hiding. Jesus had told them on several occasions that He would rise on the third day, but they had no understanding of what that meant. When the women went to the tomb they were expecting to find a body to anoint, not angels sharing the resurrection news. And even when that news spread and the risen Jesus began to appear to people, there was confusion, uncertainty and fear.

We don't know the future. Each Saturday we don't know what Sunday will bring – though we might have a good idea. Most of the time it doesn't bother us but, during times of stress, when the challenges mount up and when fears build, our unknowing about tomorrow can weigh very heavily on us. Jesus told his disciples "Do not worry about tomorrow". Perhaps he was trying to prepare them for Holy Saturday when they would be filled with worries about the future.

The Easter story reminds us that no matter how bleak today seems and what worries we might have for tomorrow, the ultimate victory belongs to God. When Jesus says, "Do not worry about tomorrow" it is not a command, but a promise – God is in control so you've nothing to worry about.

So, this Holy Saturday, (19th April), perhaps take a moment to ask God to ease your worries, to show you that He is in control and to say with confidence — Alleluia, Christ Is Risen!



Notes from Borough Green Parish Council

The Council met at 7.00pm Monday 10th March 2025 at the Bowls Club. Matters raised included:



- Recreation Ground Pavilion. Cllr Sam Thrush reported completion of the first phase the excavations at the rear to resolve an ongoing damp problem in the Pavilion rear wall, retaining walls have been installed, the ground excavated down to damp course level and new damp proofing and drainage installed. As I write this the build-up of mud on the footpath is being power washed. The next phases will be a full asbestos survey and installation of a new roof with modern insulation.
- VE Day 80 planning is progressing well with a full programme elsewhere in this issue.
- Allotments have always been in short supply in Borough Green and the three
 at the Parish Church Hall have a long waiting list. But we have been contacted
 by Brian Saunders, Chair of Wrotham Allotments, that as many as three will
 be coming free shortly. Contact us for details.
- SPEEDWATCH There was an excellent presentation about Speedwatch by Alan Watson from Kent Police and the Parish Council will be looking for volunteers to give a few hours each month to try and reduce speed through the Village. Councillors were very impressed with the improvements in the Speedwatch process which ensures persistent offenders are dealt with robustly, and we are talking to our neighbours in Platt, Wrotham and Ightham about a joint initiative. - **West Kent Mind** have responded to a discussion at the COGS Discover Your Community event and will be starting a new men's group at Potters Mede on 9 April 10.30 12.30. (For details see page 21.)
- Criminal Damage and ASB. Kent Police report that one of the catapult vandals has been arrested. This is a result of closer liaison and communication between community groups and businesses. It is still most important that any incident is reported to Police either by calling 101 or on the Kent Police websitewww.kent.police.uk/ro/report/ocr/af/how-to-report-a-crime/ but also email the details of that crime to clerk@boroughgreen.gov.uk including Police incident number, street, date and time, damage and any other notes like registration numbers.
- Barry Glew, our long serving groundsman, well known to many of you, is retiring in June but his replacement Ken will be starting in April alongside Barry to learn the job and meet the residents of Borough Green.
- Borough Green Scouts are settling into their new home at Potters Mede but, for the future, they want a more permanent and dedicated venue. We have had very early discussions about the feasibility of building a new venue at Potters Mede which would keep them close to home and retain that vital access to open space and woodland.
- Devolution has generated a lot of discussion and Cllr Rayner advised that the joint KCC and Medway proposal to Government did not make the priority list, so KCC Elections will still go ahead in May 2025, and no-one knows what happens after that.



As a registered charity, it relies on its own income to operate smoothly, benefiting from tax perks, but adhering to strict financial rules. Independent from the parish council, it has its own trustees and finances, seeking council support when needed.

Revenue primarily comes from venue hire fees which are kept affordable yet essential for covering costs like heating, lighting, insurance and maintenance. Recently the hall incorporated paid parking options for non-hall users to bring in extra funding. This income will hopefully help cover rising maintenance costs and fund the improvements that aren't possible with hire fees alone.

A local benefactor donated generously to aid essential renovations of the hall showing the community's value and commitment to its future. The hall faces ongoing financial challenges like rising utility bills, maintenance costs and insurance premiums. The volunteer committee works hard to balance generating income while keeping the hall accessible to all.

Car Parking Information

There have been some recent messages on social media regarding car parking. Guidance on use of tablets for hall users will be published to remind users once they put the registration number in and click the 'ADD VEHICLE', they should wait for the screen to confirm with message 'THANK YOU FOR ADDING YOUR VEHICLE' then push 'RETURN HOME' to ensure the number is stored! Failure to register your number correctly may result in a PCN being issued.

For non-hall users parking, if the pay machine is **not** working, you can still pay online using a parking app such as 'Ringo', calling 'Ringo' direct on 020 3046 0010 quoting location '**15528**', or by contacting Gemini (phone 0208 418 0948 email **info@geminiparkingsolutions.com**). Contacting the Hall committee (who are all volunteers), or publishing questions on social media about pay machine not working, may not prevent a PCN being issued. A reminder there is a list of 'Parking Questions and Answers' available on the Village Hall Facebook page and the hall website.

Hall Maintenance Work

The committee are constantly attempting to juggle any current maintenance work and dates around the hall activities in an attempt to minimise any disruption and will keep users informed via local 'Pinboard' and media of any potential known disruptions as the work progresses.

If you are not able to vote in person on Thursday 1 May, then you can apply for a Postal Vote. The deadline for this is Monday 14 April. You can do this by visiting www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote or calling the Council on the number above.

Our ancestors fought hard for the right to vote for every adult in our community. Please make sure you use it. Councillors have their own mandate to deliver in our village, but they can only represent our views if we have our say at elections.

Devolution derailed in Kent but plans for major council shake up to go ahead

(Extracts from press release issued on 10 February)



A day after Kent was told it would not get a fast-track devolution deal, the Government told the county's council leaders that they must press ahead with their proposals for local government reorganisation as all two-tier authorities should now make plans to merge to create single authorities, and make structures simpler and more efficient.

The leaders of Kent County Council, Medway Council and all 12 district and borough councils in the county now have until 21 March to come up with an interim proposal as to how Kent and Medway could be divided into unitary authorities, with full proposals expected by 28 November.

Now that Kent will not be preparing for a mayoral election in 2026, the local elections on 1 May will go ahead as planned.
